We Are Together: Photographs of the Sichuan Earthquake, China



On display through September 30 at the Main Library, 301 York Street

Louisville, Ky. (August 28, 2009) – The earthquake that shook China's Sichuan Province was a tragedy felt by the world. Now a new exhibit at the Main Library tells the story. ***We Are Together: Photographs of the Sichuan Earthquake, China*** is a traveling exhibition documenting last year's Sichuan earthquake and its effects on the town of Chengdu. The exhibit chronicles the immediate aftermath of the quake, the rescue efforts, and subsequent rebuilding. Aside from the global impact of the tragedy, this story has a special significance for Louisville. This September, Chengdu residents will celebrate the grand opening of Xiang-E Elementary School, a school that Louisville citizens, through the Sichuan Earthquake Relief Fund, raised over \$120,000 to help rebuild.

We Are Together: Photographs of the Sichuan Earthquake, China is now on display through September 30 in the Main Library's Bernheim Gallery, 301 York Street. The exhibit is free and open to the public during regular library hours.
